

Ford could relaunch its classic Capri after forty years



The classic Ford Capri, the well-known 1970s coupe, could be relaunched with a modern twist, a price tag of around £40,000 and performance of zero to sixty miles per hour in 6.4 seconds!

The new car would have battery power and a full redesign for the first time since it was originally launched over 40 years ago. The original Capri is now very collectable and has risen sharply in value along with many other performance Fords.

It will not be a fossil fuel user but will probably be marketed as an electric five door crossover with great performance and zero emissions, a likely horsepower of around 300 with rear wheel drive and some of the original features such as the iconic four-headlight arrangement.

It will also no doubt have the latest technology included such as a large touch screen, phone charging and built-in communications and navigation.

A spokesperson for Ford said that they don't want to speculate on future vehicles but that Ford is certainly 'on a mission to make a full range of pure electric cars'.
