

Nigel Mansell sells F1 memorabilia along with 5 NM registration



Nigel Mansell has sold his collection of Formula One memorabilia in an online auction by Sotheby's on 4 -10 October 2023. The collection raised just over £2.0M and included his famous cherished registration number 5 NM which sold for £50,400 (£62,500 including fees and VAT) against a pre-sale estimate of £30-£60K.

The sale of over 300 lots spanning his entire racing career included several of his racing helmets, race suits, gloves, boots, baseball caps and many trophies all previously housed for many years in his museum in Jersey. The racing helmet from Nigel's final F1 win in Australia in July 1994 sold for £42,000, his 1992 British Grand Prix 1st place trophy made £26,400, whilst his 2020 BMW R18 'Il Leone Edition' motorbike made £21,000 (+ fees).

The Mansell Collection's car sales, servicing and parts department on Jersey is now closed, having suffered from the effects of Covid-19 and the departure of Mitsubishi from European sales which had a knock-on effect on his other franchise.

The business will now focus on motorcycle sales, servicing, clothing and various other franchises including BMW Motorrad, Triumph Motorcycles, Peugeot, MV Augusta, Moto Morini, Bluroc and Mash.
